12+ Months Before...

- [] Tour potential venues and ask all the important questions
- [] Book your ceremony and reception venues
- [] Start researching wedding planners if you plan to hire one

Insider Tips:

- Venue Selection: Consider the season and local events when selecting your date. In Grand Rapids, October is peak wedding season, so book early if you're eyeing a fall wedding.
- Budget Planning: Set aside 5-10% of your total budget as a contingency fund for unexpected expenses.
- Guest List Strategy: Create A, B, and C lists to help prioritize invitations if you need to trim numbers.

9-12 Months Before...

Essentials:

- [] Hire a wedding planner if you've decided to use one
- [] Research and book your photographer and videographer
- [] Begin looking at wedding attire inspiration
- [] Select and ask your wedding party members
- [] Research wedding insurance options

- [] Create a wedding website
- [] Send save-the-dates for destination weddings
- [] Start a wedding folder or binder to organize all materials

- **Photography**: Book your photographer early, especially if you want engagement photos for save-the-dates.
- Wedding Party: When asking friends/family to be in your wedding party, be clear about expectations and potential costs.
- Wedding Website: Include accommodation information for out-of-town guests early so they can plan accordingly.

6-9 Months Before...

Essentials:

- [] Shop for wedding attire and schedule fittings
- [] Research and book caterer if not provided by venue
- [] Research and book entertainment (band, DJ)
- [] Meet with officiant to discuss ceremony details
- [] Research and book florist
- [] Order save-the-dates (if not already sent)
- [] Research honeymoon destinations
- [] Book hotel room blocks for out-of-town guests
- [] Register for gifts

Insider Tips:

- Attire Timeline: Allow 6-8 months for wedding dress ordering and alterations.
- Entertainment: Ask your DJ or band for a "do not play" list option to avoid songs you dislike.

• **Catering**: If you have guests with dietary restrictions, discuss accommodation options with your caterer early.

4-6 Months Before...

Essentials:

- [] Select and order invitations and other stationery
- [] Book transportation for the wedding day
- [] Book accommodations for your wedding night
- [] Schedule cake tastings and book baker
- [] Purchase wedding rings
- [] Send save-the-dates (if not already sent)
- [] Begin planning rehearsal dinner
- [] Schedule hair and makeup trials
- [] Book honeymoon transportation and accommodations

Insider Tips:

- Invitations: Order 25% more invitations than you think you need to account for mistakes, last-minute additions, and keepsakes.
- **Transportation**: Consider providing transportation between the ceremony, reception, and hotels if they're not within walking distance.
- **Rings**: Allow time for sizing, engraving, and possible shipping delays when ordering rings.

2-4 Months Before...

Essentials:

- [] Finalize menu and flowers
- [] Schedule final dress fitting

- [] Write your vows (if writing your own)
- [] Review and finalize ceremony details with officiant
- [] Send wedding invitations
- [] Create a seating chart system
- [] Purchase gifts for wedding party, parents, and each other
- [] Book a photo booth, if desired
- [] Arrange welcome baskets for out-of-town guests
- [] Plan and book honeymoon activities

- Invitations: Send invitations 8-10 weeks before the wedding, with an RSVP deadline 3-4 weeks before your date.
- Seating Chart: Use a spreadsheet or online tool that allows for easy adjustments as RSVPs come in.
- Welcome Baskets: Include local treats, a schedule of events, maps, and activity suggestions.

1-2 Months Before...

Essentials:

- [] Follow up on missing RSVPs
- [] Create a detailed timeline for the wedding day
- [] Finalize seating chart
- [] Confirm all vendor arrangements and timelines
- [] Have final dress fitting
- [] Break in wedding shoes
- [] Finalize ceremony program
- [] Apply for marriage license
- [] Finalize wedding vows

- [] Create or review shot list with photographer
- [] Confirm honeymoon reservations

- Marriage License: In Michigan, marriage licenses are valid for 33 days from the date of application. Apply 2-4 weeks before your wedding.
- Vendor Confirmation: Send final head counts, timelines, and special requests to all vendors one month before the wedding.
- Wedding Day Timeline: Build in buffer time throughout the day—everything takes longer than you think!

2-4 Weeks Before...

Essentials:

- [] Final venue walkthrough with vendors
- [] Create final timeline for wedding party and family
- [] Pick up wedding rings
- [] Final head count to venue and caterer
- [] Arrange seating chart and place cards
- [] Pick up wedding attire
- [] Confirm all transportation arrangements
- [] Prepare final payments and gratuities for vendors
- [] Pack for honeymoon
- [] Delegate wedding day tasks to wedding party or family

Insider Tips:

- Vendor Payments: Prepare final payments in labeled envelopes and assign someone trustworthy to distribute them.
- **Packing**: Create a separate "day-after" bag with comfortable clothes and essentials for the morning after your wedding.

• **Delegation**: Assign a point person (not you!) for each vendor to handle questions or issues on the wedding day.

1 Week Before...

Essentials:

- [] Final confirmation with all vendors
- [] Give final guest count to caterer
- [] Break in wedding shoes (if not already done)
- [] Pack wedding day emergency kit
- [] Get beauty treatments (facial, manicure, etc.)
- [] Pick up welcome baskets/gift bags
- [] Prepare wedding day timeline for wedding party
- [] Confirm photo ID for marriage license
- [] Prepare payment envelopes for vendors
- [] Deliver welcome baskets to hotel

Insider Tips:

- Emergency Kit: Include safety pins, fashion tape, pain relievers, stain remover, breath mints, tissues, and a sewing kit.
- Vendor Tips: Prepare gratuities in labeled envelopes to be distributed on the wedding day.
- Self-Care: Schedule some downtime to relax and enjoy your final days as an engaged couple.

The Day Before...

Essentials:

• [] Attend rehearsal and rehearsal dinner

- [] Give gifts to wedding party and parents
- [] Prepare wedding attire and accessories
- [] Confirm wake-up times and morning schedule
- [] Print final copies of vows and speeches
- [] Get to bed early!

- Rehearsal: Bring all ceremony items (readings, unity candle, etc.) to the rehearsal.
- Hydration: Drink plenty of water and avoid excessive alcohol at the rehearsal dinner.
- **Delegation**: Hand off your phone to a trusted friend or family member to handle any last-minute calls or texts.

WEDDING DAY!!!

Essentials:

- [] Eat breakfast!
- [] Allow plenty of time for hair and makeup
- [] Give wedding rings to best man/maid of honor
- [] Take a moment alone to center yourself
- [] Remember to eat and drink water throughout the day
- [] Take your marriage license to the ceremony for signing
- [] ENJOY YOUR DAY!

Insider Tips:

- Timeline: Add 25% more time than you think you need for getting ready.
- Photos: Consider a "first look" before the ceremony for intimate photos and to calm nerves.
- Mindfulness: Take mental snapshots throughout the day—it goes by quickly!

After The Wedding

Essentials:

- [] Return any rented items
- [] Begin thank-you notes (within 3 months)
- [] Preserve wedding dress and bouquet (if desired)
- [] Change name (if applicable)
- [] Update accounts with new name/address
- [] Submit wedding photos to venue and vendors (they love to see them!)

Insider Tips:

- Thank-You Notes: Keep a spreadsheet of gifts received and thank-you notes sent.
- Name Change: Create a checklist of all accounts that need updating (social security, driver's license, passport, bank accounts, etc.).
- **Reviews**: Leave reviews for your vendors—it helps their businesses and helps other couples.

Frequently Forgotten Items:

- [] Arrange for cake cutting set and toasting flutes
- [] Plan for meals on the wedding day before the reception
- [] Designate someone to take gifts home after the reception
- [] Arrange for wedding dress steaming
- [] Plan for decor setup and teardown
- [] Create rain/weather contingency plans
- [] Prepare tip envelopes for vendors
- [] Assign someone to bustle the wedding dress
- [] Bring comfortable shoes for reception dancing
- [] Designate someone to return rentals after the wedding

- [] Create a plan for leftover food and cake
- [] Assign someone to gather personal items at the end of the night
